A week in Kansas City!

We partnered with the following groups:

 - KCK Food Pantry sorted food
 - Central Food Pantry donated 200 tuna salad/chicken salad kits, bagged 800 lunch sacks and sorted food
 - $\circ~$ Eileen's Place weeded their vegetable garden and got it cleaned up
- Harvester's Food Pantry labeled and counted pallets of food
- Ivanhoe Community Garden picked fruit, weeded and mulched fruit trees
- Orchard weeded and mulched 160 fruit trees
- Community Linc deep cleaned and made ready 7 apartments and sorted in the clothes closet
- Connections to Success we worked in Keisha's Closet sorting clothes
- St. Mark Hope and Peace Lutheran spring cleaned and organized, painted, created a welcoming fellowship area and children's area.
- Kansas City Community Garden- weeded, helped prepare plots for new vegetation, dug fence post holes
- The Gathering Table made breakfast, organized in the food pantry and clothes closet

We are proud of the hard work our young people did in the community – two days they skipped their free time and opted to continue working on work sites which gave them 12 hour work days. They are tired, but it is a good tired as they got to impact the world being the hands and feet of Christ.
