




## The Passion Chorale

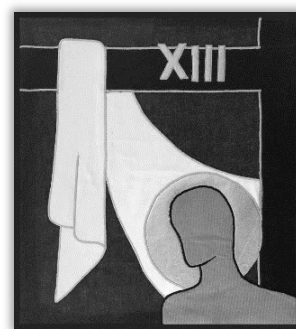

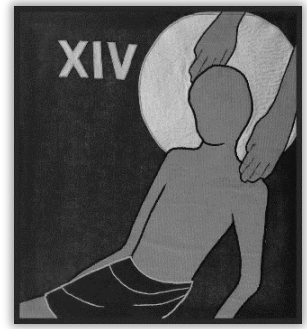
