Lent is a season in the church where we turn our focus to God and strengthen our lives of faith is this chaotic world. Ash Wednesday is actually Valentine's day this year, which leaves me with a smirk. While people everywhere say "I love you," the pastors will be reminding us that we are all going to die! I don't think will work on a card to your sweetheart, but let's think about it for a minute. Lent reminds us that our lives are brief. We should stop and recognize the people around us and take the time to tell them, "I love you." It also is a reminder that no matter what happens in this life and world, God loves us, and that we need to hear that too. Maybe Ash Wednesday and Valentine's day work very well together!

Calvary will encourage you this Lent, to deepen your faith in a couple of ways. First, we will host a Lenten Retreat on Feb 9-10 that will prepare us for the work ahead. Retired Pastor Wayne Menking will lead us through discussions from his book about living out our faith in these chaotic times. (Pr Wayne also happens to be one of my former pastors when I was young!). We will be using the lens of Luther's Large Catechism as well as Menking's book From Survival to Vocation. Time is running out, so if you have not registered, go to the Calvary website and do so today. It is only \$20 a person and it will be a wonderfully engaging experience open to the public, so bring a friend. Do not miss this opportunity to kick off Lent!

We will spend time reflecting each Wednesday night with our Lenten service led by our confirmation class. Our theme this year, invites us to remember that since the foundations of the world, God was there. The Holy Spirit hovered over the waters at creation and it hovers around us even now. When God's people were captive in Egypt, God did not abandon them, but guided them into the land of Promise. God continues to guide us. Christ was born into our world as a baby, and the promise of Emmanuel, or "God with us" is still true for us today. Our theme this year is "God is Still With Us." God is near, when we experience comfort and pain, celebration and heartache, joy and suffering. God sticks beside God's people in all times and in all places and reminds us that God knows what it is like to be human and to be with us in all of our experiences.

We will also have **two other resources available** for you this Lent. The first will be a weekly Lenten devotion geared toward adults. Each of the seven devotions (one per week, Ash Wednesday through Easter), has a scripture reading, illustrations for coloring in prayer, a reflection, questions for discussion or personal reflection and a prayer. Secondly, we will also have a weekly packet for families to guide parents and children with age appropriate questions for reflection and activities to deepen faith in the home. If you are not able to come in person to pick up these devotions we will make them available to you through the member portal, 360 Unite or mail them to you

directly. Please reach out if you need help accessing them so that everyone can participate. May God bless us and our walk through Lent together.





Hello church family,

Remember how the children told us the story of Jesus' birth in December? Well, Calvary took that story to heart, especially the part about "no room in the inn". Calvary has special company in the winter. There are grown ups that come to have a lock-in on Tuesdays! It is kind of like a lock in because they sleep here and eat yummy food, but they don't stay up late, they don't play hide and go seek in the dark or basketball, and they are the quietest lock-in ever. Thankfully they eat and drop crumbs, so that is the same! They don't sleep-in like the other lock ins I have been to before — they had a special breakfast from Pastor Phil and his friends, packed their stuff and were gone by 7am. Just like Mary and Joseph had no place to stay on Jesus' birthday, some people even today don't have a place to stay. So, just like the innkeeper did, we open our doors and hearts to these people every Tuesday with a warm bed, hot showers, awesome food and a safe place they can rest. My job on Tuesdays is to jump on the beds and make sure they are inflated to the right bounce (and of course crumb patrol)! Our family is collecting winter coats and hoodies from our other friends because if people are cold, so are our mouse friends. If you want to look in your closets for men's coats and hoodies that still have warmth to give please bring them up! I am sure Margaret will make sure they go to a good home.

This past month there were teenagers here that I didn't recognize. I found out they were here from other churches in the area for Peer Ministry training. They even had a special "commissioning". I don't really understand that word, but they got a special prayer and towel and then were told to go make a difference in the world. Pastor Phil said we are counting on our teenagers! Peer Ministers learn about the Good Samaritan story (and more stuff too) and then go into the world to live the Good Samaritan story. It is a good story and you might think this is the first time that this little mouse heard it, but no! This is one of the stories on the wall in the Family Life Center because it was one of Pastor Eric's favorites. Momma and Daddy had us learn all about the mural — we have studied all of the stories and learned the song too!

I am so glad all of the regulars are here every week. The voices and laughter are bouncy on the walls and make our family happy! One group that is not here all of time is Via de Christo staff training. Yummy! They have a lot of goodies and I am sure they have a lot of Jesus time once they finish chewing! Speaking of laughter — Calvary loves to welcome visitors and we have one new friend who loves to laugh and clap. Momma says he shows his joy on the outside, while most stoic Lutherans show it on the inside. Well, I like joy on the outside! I hear him coming

down the hallway every Sunday to get his offering from Janelle and find his friends. He loves church so much that he usually goes to all four services. I am going to practice having more joy on the outside. Joy on the outside makes everyone smile more on Sunday mornings. Momma taught me a song that she sang as a little mouse and it is my new favorite. If you listen carefully when you are at church you might hear me singing!


