With joy and thanksgiving, Congregation Council is pleased to provide this update!

What a blessing to choose from so many things to highlight as God's Work, Human Hands! It is always fun, and humbling, to reflect on the vibrant life of Calvary and the gracious community of which we all are part. Calvary is a special place.

We welcomed 14 families in membership and look forward to welcoming more this fall. We were blessed by a shared experience with Pastor CeCee Mills, Secretary of the ELCA, who led our Lenten Retreat and preached three completely different sermons the next day, wow! Our gifted and dedicated Property Committee facilitated, managed and performed many projects, including repaving the north parking lot and replacing the windows in the hallway between the fellowship hall and the nursery. Tremendous thanks from the congregation to Calvary member Chuck Lanham and Lanham Window Company for your generous donation of the windows and their installation!

Congregation Council has been focused on specific objectives for this year, including Pastoral Care, Stewardship, Safety/Security and Audiovisual. Last year we implemented a new model for Pastoral Care, based on care and advocacy, where the focus is on actively listening and identifying ways to encourage, guide and support our pastors' self-care. Last year we began with forming Pastor Kyle Rouze's committee, and earlier this year we formed Pastor Kyle Symanski's committee. As a congregation, we experienced the Seasons of Stewardship – Our Selves, Our Time and Our Possessions, through which we explored what it means to be a good steward of the gifts God first gave us. We now have informative pew safety cards with key information related to safety and security. Members of the Security Committee have met with nearly all Calvary ministries and will wrap up this effort in the fall. We continue seeking to improve quality, consistency and reliability of the audio experience for worship in person at all three Sunday worship services, worship online for two Sunday worship services, and for all special services.

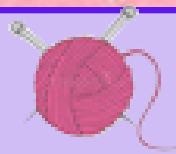
