COUNCIL CORNER: YOUTH & FAMILY MINISTRY



This summer, our day camp theme was **MISSION POSSIBLE: GOD'S LOVE IN ACTION** and challenged us to discover what happens when we put God's love into action. Our theme verse, "For mortals it is impossible, but for God all things are possible" (Matthew 19:26), reminded us that we don't have to do God's work alone. God is already at work in us and through us, making possible things we may not be able to accomplish on our own.

We explored how God's love shapes our lives. God's love **CHOOSES** us: we are seen, valued, and called by God—not because of what we accomplish, but simply because we are God's beloved children.

God's love **CHANGES** us: when we experience God's grace and love, we are transformed from the inside out.

God's love welcomes us into **COMMUNITY**: faith is not meant to be lived alone. We belong to one another, and our differences, gifts, and stories make our community stronger.

God **CALLS** us to love: we should take what we have received and share it with others through kindness, compassion, service, forgiveness, and courage.

As we begin a new school year, these themes can become more than memories from camp - they can guide our year.

Our mission is still possible - not because we can do everything on our own, but because God's love is already at work in us, around us, and through us. As we journey through the coming year, may we continue to live out our theme - Mission Possible: God's Love in Action.

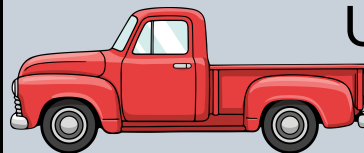

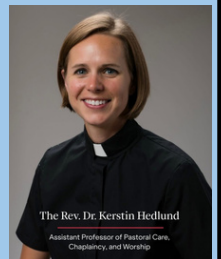

My momma and daddy have been playing a lot of Dolly Parton in our mouse hole this week. We have also re-read lots of the books from the Imagination Library and talked about how Dolly showed love to children she never met, through books. Momma helped Janelle write a little high school devotion and she thought I should share it, because mice and humans need to be reminded that they are loved by Jesus!
