Your contributions are part of God's plan to bring the light of Christ into this very dark place. Thank you for being willing to be in His plan.

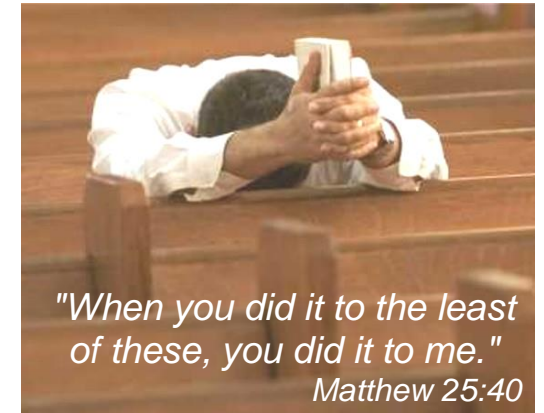

Kairos is an ecumenical, worldwide ministry that brings the love of God and the light of Christ into prisons. An army of volunteers rally to become the hands and feet of Christ for 42 inmates who come seeking a new way of life.

At the Coffield Men's Prison Unit near Palestine, TX, the men work on the inside team and the ladies work on the outside, then attend the closing. You can serve with or without your spouse.

Make Cookies

Homemade cookies, filled with prayer and love become tangible examples of the love of God poured out by His family.

Cookies used at Coffield are all handmade. No store bought cookies.



What Kind of Cookies?

Chocolate Chip, oatmeal and peanut butter are favorites

Cookie "Please Do's"

- Cool, Cool, Cool !!! Otherwise they stick
- One dozen in a quart size zip lock bag
- Freeze until you can arrange for delivery to a team member
- For more than a couple dozen, layering in a small box separated by wax paper works great

Cookie "Please Don't Do's"

Don't include fruit; or add icing, nuts or other toppings to the cookies

Note: We use 1,500-2,000 dozen cookies on a weekend, so we need a lot of help!

Agape

Make Placemats

At each meal, placemats made by children are used. These handmade placemats are powerful tools of the Holy Spirit that can break open a lifetime of sorrow and let the love of Christ in.



This is a great activity for Sunday school, preschool, children and grand children!

Placemat Guidelines

- Decorated by children
- Simple message of God's love
- Include child's first name only and age
- Preferred size is 11 x 17

Make Posters

Sunday school classes, Bible study groups, reunion groups, youth groups, and even families can make a poster that expresses the hope found in Christ.

These messages of love from the Body of Christ have a powerful impact on hardened hearts.



Poster Guidelines

- What is on the poster is not so important. It can be a simple trace of hands or a beautiful work of art.
- It should have the name of the group
- It should have the group's signatures (if kids, first name only and age)
- No stickers or glue.
